
# Career Opportunities in Northeastern PA





Retirement risk is high in Lackawanna County, PA. The national average for an area this size is 65,242 people 55 or older, while there are 74,375 here.




#### **Racial Diversity**


Racial diversity is low in Lackawanna County, PA. The national average for an area this size is 90,009 racially diverse people, while there are 41,988 here.

### **Educational Attainment**




